#### **CAUTION \***=

Do not apply at temperatures below 10°C and over 45°C.

Do not over-thin. Use thinned paint within 24 hours.

Tightly close the lid when not in use and store in a cool, dry place.

Flaky, powdery substrate should not be painted without proper re-plastering.

Do not apply on Bituminous, Asphalt, ceramic tiles, or glossy substrate.

Use on porous cement or ash brickwork can result in the coating peeling from substrate.

Do not apply on surfaces that are subject to continuous seepage or dampness.

Improper levelling of paver blocks/surface, which will lead to erosion of substrate and paint, should be levelled properly before application of paint.

# **APPLICATION**

- Ensure that the surface to be painted is free from any damp or loose paint, dust, oil, wax, grease or any other contaminants.
- Remove all contaminants such as dirt, grease, oil, dust, etc., with soap-powder solution using a Scrubbing Brush and Jet Wash. Remove algae or fungus from affected area. Dry for a minimum of 4-6 hours before painting. Moisture content on the surface should be less than 16%.
- For freshly made concrete surface, allow it to cure for at least 4 weeks before painting.
- Check random areas for adhesion of existing paint film. If problems are observed, total removal of old paint is required.
- Sand smooth, glossy surfaces and the surfaces previously coated with solvent-based paints with sandpaper no. 120 to improve adhesion.

ROLLER Apply with Long Nap Felt Roller or Brush.

# **ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH AND SAFETY**

- · Use only with adequate ventilation during application and drying.
- · Avoid contact with eyes and prolonged or repeated contact with skin.
- · Do not breathe spray mist or sanding dust.
- · Use dust mask or nose pad during application, sanding and clean up.
- · Close container after each use.
- · Wash thoroughly after handling.
- In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice.
- In case of skin contact, immediately wash skin with soap and plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation develops or persists.
- · No added Lead, Mercury, Chromium, Arsenic and other heavy metals.

### **POST PAINTING CARE**

- Prevent water stagnation and overgrowth of plants and trees near the painted surface.
- Prevent sharp objects or impacts that could damge paint film.
- Allow at least 48 hours of curing before foot traffic begins. Regular traffic can begin only after 72 hours of curing. Duration given for drying must be extended in cold, damp, or humid conditions.
- Avoid movement of heavy vehicles and heavy sharp objects, this may rupture the film and lead to film failure.
- For best performance, ensure proper washing and cleaning of the painted surface every 6 months.
- Do not wash the painted surface with a metal wire brush.
